The Los Angeles ACO Branch has received your reference letter requesting a global AMOC to FAA AD 2016-03-06 for installation of TDG Aerospace UFI STC ST02502LA.

TDG Aerospace UFI STC ST02502LA provides an acceptable level of safety and is approved as a global AMOC to FAA AD 2016-03-06 paragraph (g) for installation on Boeing Company airplanes DC-9 / MD-80 / MD-90 models listed in paragraph (c) Applicability of this AD.

Previous installations in accordance with paragraph (l)(4) of this AD are valid.

In accordance with FAA Order 8110-103, the following conditions apply:


1. All provisions of FAA AD 2016-03-06 that are not specifically referenced above remain fully applicable and must be complied with accordingly.
2. This approval is applicable to Boeing Company airplanes DC-9 / MD-80 / MD-90 models listed in paragraph (c) Applicability of this AD.
3. This FAA AMOC is transferable with the aircraft to other operators.
4. If the aircraft is registered with the United States of America, the operator must notify their appropriate principal inspector, or lacking a principal inspector, the manager of the local flight standards district office or certificate holding district office.
5. This AMOC only applies to the FAA AD listed above. The FAA does not have the authority to approve this as an AMOC to any AD issued by another civil aviation

authority (CAA). Approval of an AMOC to another CAA's AD must come from that CAA
